**Activity Agreement**

*Every Scout, a parent of each Scout and every adult leader must sign this form. In addition, a permission slip must be completed for each off-site troop activity event.*

Boy Scout activities allow a safe environment to demonstrate the principles and beliefs found in the **Scout Oath** and **Scout Law**. This agreement is a promise to myself and others that I will do my best to live the **Scout Oath** and **Scout Law** during troop activities.

**The Scout Oath: On my honor, I will do my best, to do my duty, to God and my country, and to obey the Scout Law. To help others at all times, to keep myself physically strong, mentally awake and morally straight. The three promises in the Scout Oath are Duty to God and country, Duty to other people, and Duty to self.**

**The Scout Law: A Scout is trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, kind, obedient, cheerful, thrifty, brave, clean and reverent.**

Translating our beliefs into real expectations, every Scout and Scouter agrees:

- To look for the highest good in all – **Duty to others.**
- To fully participate with the group in all scheduled troop activities – **Duty to self.**
- To support and show proper respect for myself, the other scouts and adult leaders by not initiating or taking part in put downs, pranks or judgments of others – **Duty to self, duty to others; A Scout is friendly, courteous, and kind.**
- Not to use offensive language or tell offensive jokes – **A Scout is reverent.**
- To respect the facilities, vehicles, equipment, environment, and everyone's personal property – **A Scout is trustworthy and kind.**
- To follow directions and remain in designated areas – **Duty to self, duty to others; A Scout is obedient.**
- Not to enter the tents of other scouts without permission- **A Scout is trustworthy.**
- To honor quiet time and lights out – **Duty to self, Duty to others; A Scout is courteous and obedient.**
- To refrain from aggressive roughhousing, fighting and other inappropriate physical contact – **Duty to self, duty to others; A Scout is loyal, friendly, courteous, and kind.**

I understand that if I cannot conduct myself according to our Scouting beliefs by not meeting the expectations as agreed to above, a parent or guardian will be called and I will be removed from the activity in question. I will not be able to attend a future Troop activity until I participate in a counseling meeting between myself, my parent or guardian and the Troop Scoutmaster.
